Today, Valery Rotenberg is working with AM Studio in Toronto. Founded by Orly and Giora Meyer, AM Studio showcases their family of gifted Israeli artists and designers. They have carried out commissioned work in synagogues, hospitals, community centres and commercial installations around the world using a variety of creative techniques including stained glass and contemporary fused stained glass.

- The Ark and the Reader's Table will be moved to floor level - making the entire chapel user friendly and barrier-free.
- A designated location for wheelchairs.
- Cabinet drawers provided for secure storage of talit-tefillin
